They were the worst-behaved class in the whole school.






But the class would not settle down.

And they always refused to do their lessons.




"Something will have to be done," said Miss Nelson.

Miss Nelson's kids did as they were told.







They could see that Miss Swamp was a real witch.

And she loaded them down with homework.




"We'll have no story hour today," said Miss Swamp.

"Keep your mouths shut," said Miss Swamp.


"Sit perfectly still," said Miss Swamp.

Other kids went to Miss Nelson's house.


The shades were tightly drawn, and no one answered the door.


In fact, the only person they did see was the wicked Miss Viola Swamp, coming up the street.

They got away just in time.






Maybe something *terrible* happened to Miss Nelson!

But that didn't seem likely.






"Maybe Miss Nelson went to Mars!" said another kid. But that didn't seem likely either.

The kids in Room 207 became very discouraged.


It seemed that Miss Nelson was never coming back.


And they would be stuck with Miss Viola Swamp forever.

"That's my little secret," said Miss Nelson.


"How about a story hour?"



#### As You Read

Think about what helps each gross plant survive

Our world is full of incredible plants. Some of them smell wonderful. Some of them look beautiful. And some of them are just *gross*.

We've found three of the world's grossest plants. Learn all about them . if you dare!

#### Stinky Plant

The rafflesia (ruh-FLEE-zhuh) plant is big, red, bumpy, and stinky. It smells

like rotten meat! That smell might sound gross to you. But not everyone feels that way.


Some insects eat rotten meat. When they get a whiff of the rafflesia, they think they're smelling a tasty meal. They crawl around on the flower to take a closer look, and they get covered in dusty **pollen**.

The insects fly away and carry the pollen to other rafflesia plants. The pollen helps those plants make new seeds. One day, those seeds will

> sprout. And more stinky rafflesia plants will grow somewhere new!

#### Slimy Plant

Smell isn't the only gross way for plants to get what they need. Take a look at the Sierra Mixe corn plant. It looks like it has gooey red fingers





growing out of it.

Those slime-covered things are roots!

The roots of most plants grow under the ground. They soak up **nutrients** from the soil. Nutrients are what living things need to stay strong and healthy.

But the Sierra Mixe grows its roots in the air instead of the ground. Its roots are covered in a thick slime called **mucus**. The mucus looks disgusting, but it has an important job.

The mucus pulls nutrients right out of the air. The corn plant grows strong, healthy—and gross!

#### **Toilet Plant**

This last plant might be the grossest one of all. It's called a pitcher plant. Pitcher plants grow in places where they can't get enough nutrients from the soil.

So some pitcher plants get their pit


nutrients in a totally disgusting way.

The pitcher plant is shaped like a big cup. Animals sit on its edge to lick sweet **nectar** from the plant. While the animals are resting there, they use the plant as a toilet. They poop right into the cup!

The poop is just what the pitcher plant needs. The plant breaks down the poop and gets plenty of nutrients. And the animal gets a nice bathroom break!

These plants may not smell sweet.
They may not look pretty. But these
three gross plants are amazing!
The things that make them gross are
exactly what they need to survive.


#### Drawing Instructions: Giraffe

Reference Drawing Lesson Sheet

- 1. Draw 2 circles for the eyes
- 2. Add angle line inside of each circle
- 3. Fill in area black around angle line
- 4. Add a large curve line above the eyes for the top of the head.
- 5. Draw the nose close to the bottom of the paper using a small curve line and a deeper curve line under it.
- 6. Add 2 circles filled in black for the nostrils on the nose. Connect the top of the head to the nose using a curve line on each side of the face.
- 7. Draw 2 curve lines to a point for each ear.
- 8. Add another curve line in the middle of the ear to divide the outer ear from the inner ear. Color the inside of the ear black.
- 9. Draw horns between the ears by using 2 straight lines and a curve line for each horn. Add a neck by drawing a line from the right ear to the right side of the paper and then another line from the nose to the bottom right hand corner.
- 10.Draw hair using straight lines between the ears and down the top of the neck. Add giraffe spots on the face using curve lines in a square movement.


