


In spring, flowers **bloom**: That means they grow and open up. Here are some of the first flowers to bloom in spring.






If a bird snatches up the worm, it might fly to its **nest** and feed its chicks.

Hello, again! I hope things are going as smoothly as possible for you and yours during these stay-at-home weeks. Reconnecting with our families is so precious.




