The criteria on which you will be judged are:

1. academic achievement
2. academic potential
3. personal responsibility
4. commitment to future education
5. promise to fulfill your education commitment
6. **an accumulative grade point average of at least 4.0 on a 5.0 scale;**

Scholarships will be awarded at the Senior Honors Night.
